



The Bells here at St. Peter's Church

We have six bells for change ringing and one clock bell that chimes the hours.

The oldest bell is dated c1500, three from the 1700's one from 1879 and one from 1948 when the original five were augmented to the six that we ring today.

The heaviest, Tenor bell weighs 11½ cwt.

We are part of the Devizes branch of the Salisbury Diocesan Guild of Ringers and meet for practice on Tuesday evenings at 7:15pm where ringers of all standards are most welcome.
